


# Art of the Plains 2016 Over \$18,000.00 in Awards

GARLAND A. WEEKS

Garland Weeks delights in the natural forms, emotions, and nuances of Mother Nature, which continually sources his sculptures with new, creative, and innovative ideas. He says that he is "still in awe of the ever changing subtleties of nature and the impact such changes have on the artistic inner spirit. The turn of a foot, the drop of an eyelid, the nuance of a smile—the observations of which can be the lifeblood – the heartbeat – of a new, interpretive creation of art."

This along with his combined interests in literature, science, history, cultural heritage, social culture, and personal rodeo and cowboy experience, he is never at a loss for new thoughts and grand ideas to make his works. He is currently creating several sculptures and awards for the National College Baseball Hall of Fame and Foundation in Lubbock, Texas.

Garland began sculpting as a hobby in 1970 and continued this moonlighting activity while also being actively engaged in the cattle feeding industry as a market analyst, commodity broker, and agricultural economist. In 1978, Garland took the plunge into making art full-time and has never looked back. He has lived, worked, and sculpted in California, Colorado, Oklahoma, Texas, etc. honing his skills. # Sales commission of 30% will apply and will benefit both Fort Concho National Historic Landmark and the American Plains Artists

#### **Jury Process via Digital Entries**

Initial jurying will be from the submitted Digital Entries sent via email. To enter digitally, go to the Call for Entries Page on the APA website then click on the 2016 Digital Entry Form link. Submitted entries will be reviewed by a panel of APA Signature Members on the aesthetic and technical skills of the artist in depicting the theme of the Great Plains. Awards juror Garland Weeks, will choose works to receive awards after viewing the original works selected for inclusion in the exhibit.

#### **Eligibility**

Open to artists working in any traditional 2D or 3D fine art media in a realistic or representational manner reflecting the theme of the American Plains completed within the last three years, original work only and not previously shown in an Annual Juried APA Show. No photography or computer generated art accepted. We must have both the image size of the artwork itself and the outside dimensions of the frame. The maximum size for 2D work is 1564 square inches including the outside dimension of the frame. An example of that is a 24" x 36" artwork with a five inch frame. Sculpture would be of moderate size and not exceed 100 pounds. Artwork must represent the theme of the show. All works must be for sale, with a 30% commission collected on all sales.

#### **Note: Shipping information**

Accepted artists will be sent specific instructions for shipment/delivery of artwork to the Fort Concho National Historic Landmark in their acceptance letter. However, artists should be aware that they are responsible for all shipping costs to and from the museum and that there is a \$15 fee per crate/box.

Art should be sent in sturdy reusable containers. Do Not use Styrofoam peanuts of any kind, Bubblewrap is recommended. Accepted artists will pay \$15.00 to Fort Concho NHL per crate/box for unboxing/uncrating and reboxing/recrating their artwork. It should be sent at the time the artists ship their work. If a new box or extra bubblewrap, etc. is needed to be purchased to re-pack the artwork, then a fee will be charged in addition to the \$15.00 boxing fee. All artwork must be sent and returned by Fed Ex or UPS paid by the artist. A pre-paid completed return label will be required by the end of the show.
